



THE SUMMER 'ZIGZAG' TIMETABLE

During July and August we operate a 'zigzag' timetable. This means that students study and have their social programme on alternate mornings and afternoons. This has many benefits for the students:

- Most famous attractions are very crowded in the afternoons. We organise morning visits and so avoid the queues.
- Certain places such as the Houses of Parliament can only be visited in the mornings. Students don't have to miss lessons to go there.
- If students want to go away for a long weekend, every two weeks they finish on Friday lunchtime and start back on Monday afternoon.
- Students can have a lie-in if they have had a big night out!
- Students of the same nationalities can be separated by placing them on opposite zig zag timetables (Timetable A or Timetable B)

Lessons are at the following times:

Morning lessons

08.30 – 10.00 lesson
10.00 – 10.20 *break*
10.20 – 11.50 lesson

Afternoon lessons

14.40 – 16.10 lesson
16.10 – 16.30 *break*
16.30 – 18.00 lesson

- If students choose a 21-hour course, they will also have lessons 12.50 – 14.20 (Monday to Thursday).
- If students choose a 22.5-hour course, they will also have lessons 12.50 – 14.20 (Monday to Friday).

All students receive individual copies of their own timetable.
