



Code of Conduct for Students Under 18 years (individuals)

If you are 16 or 17 years old, you are considered a 'child' under U.K. Law. There are U.K. laws to protect any person under 18, and Excel English has policies to support you during your stay here.

At School/ Accommodation

- You should attend every lesson. If you cannot attend because you are ill (or for another reason), please phone the school to tell us
- You should spend every break time in a communal area (Student Room, Self-Access Centre, Garden)
- You must return to your homestay by 22.00 (16 yr. olds) or 23.00 (17 yr. olds). If you are late, you must phone your homestay host to tell them where you are and when you will be home

General Rules

- Do not buy or drink alcohol (it is against the law)
- Do not buy cigarettes (it is against the law)
- Do not buy/use / handle illegal drugs (it is against the law)
- Do not experiment with 'legal highs' (they are now illegal and very dangerous)

General Guidelines

- Be careful when you are online (do not share personal information or photos with people you do not know)
- Be tolerant of other viewpoints. Excel English (and the U.K. in general) welcomes people of all races, religions and backgrounds, and we expect all students to do the same
- Do not speak to people you do not know on the street and never get into a stranger's car

The rules above are there to make sure you have a safe and enjoyable time at Excel English. If you do not comply with the above Code of Conduct, your parents/legal guardians will be contacted immediately, and you will be sent home.
